Third quarter is going to be very busy for third grade. (Isn't that the motto for every quarter?!?) We will begin our American Hero Projects this quarter. Students will research an American Hero throughout the quarter. They will pick their hero the first full week of school after break. The culmination of the project will be a wax museum where students "become" their hero. Parents, faculty members and students are invited to attend the wax museum. In my opinion, this is the biggest project for the third grade year, and the one the kids get most excited about and will remember from their HTS career! I love seeing the pride in the students' faces when they get to become the hero they researched over the course of the quarter. I know the kids will work hard and your support is always tremendously appreciated. I will send more information very soon and a timeline of due dates as I have in the past with other projects. Finally, due to days off and short weeks, our reading schedule will look a little different for the next few weeks. We will start reading unit 3.3 on Thursday (1/3/19). Therefore, their weekly test will be on Wednesday 1/9/19. We will begin unit 3.5 on 1/10/19, and taking the weekly test (for unit 3.5) on 1/14/19.
